


Declaration of Matthew Greene

I, Matthew Greene, hereby state the following facts, all of which are based on my personal experience and knowledge, and to which I would testify if called upon:

1. In September 2016 I will be graduating with a Bachelor of Arts degree from Weinberg College at Northwestern University.
2. I was enrolled in a seminar called "Rule of Law and its Critics," taught by Professor Jacqueline Stevens, for the winter quarter of 2016.
3. My experience in Dr. Stevens' class was positive. It was a dynamic, discussion-based, interesting class. I have never seen Dr. Stevens acting in an aggressive or demeaning way; she was always constructive and helpful.
4. On March 8, 2016 I dropped by Dr. Stevens' office to drop off a draft of a final paper. She was not in her office. A woman in Dr. Stevens's office told me she was in a meeting. After waiting briefly in the hall I heard a male voice yelling and heard the phrase "Get out!" and then I heard a door slam. I did not hear any female voice. I then saw Professor Stevens walking towards me looking startled and flustered.
5. I was interviewed with a third-party attorney about this incident, and I stated something substantially similar to what I related above. The interviewer took notes while I was speaking.
